Quick Reference Guide - iTroll G2.5
Manually Controlling Motor Speed

Turn iTroll On:




Press and Release

Turn iTroll Off:





Press and HOLD for 3 Seconds

Maximum Throttle
Press and HOLD
To advance throttle to 100%.




Secondary Cruising Speed:


 **Then**  **HOLD**

When the MAX button is held down and the throttle level is increasing, you can stop the advancement and **LOCK** the throttle by pressing the run button. iTroll will **HOLD** the locked throttle setting until you release it by pressing the run button.

Adjust Throttle
The "Click Dial" is **dual resolution and can move the throttle in 1.0% or 0.1% steps.**




Change Throttle Resolution




Orange LED in keypad is lit when throttle is in 0.1% steps (FINE RESOLUTION).

Recall Last Idles
Displays the last 3 throttle values that were being used when the Idle button was pressed. **This is valuable info as these were speeds where fish were caught!**




Press and HOLD

Go To HUNT Mode

If DRAG Mode is ON, and the dial is set **HIGHER** than the stored Drag Speed, throttle goes to **Drag Mode**.

If DRAG Mode is OFF, or if DRAG mode is on and the dial is set **LOWER** than the stored Drag Speed, the motor will go to **IDLE**.



DRAG Mode

Allows you to fight fish at a lower throttle setting than your trolling speed. By not being at idle, you can keep your lines off the bottom or adjust the throttle to keep your boat's heading.

Adjust DRAG Speed

Go To Idle

When HUNT Mode loads, you land on the "Start" screen
There are **Two Types of Programs** and the screens show their throttle and time settings.

HUNT Mode Information:


- Cut & Bump programs consist of two throttle and time pairs.
- iTroll runs the pairs in timed sequences.
- The throttle with the longest time period is set as the trolling throttle and is displayed on the LEFT side of the screen.
- The cut or bump throttle is displayed on the RIGHT side of the screen.
- There are SIX Hunt programs in iTroll's memory. This allows you have programs for different wind / current conditions or bait presentations!
- The ability to switch programs makes HUNT Mode incredibly versatile AND easy to use!

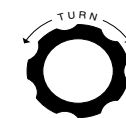
BUMP Throttle Programs

Cut programs - When the throttle cuts, it looks like the bait is tired or dying, causing fish to strike. They don't have to work hard - when the bait stalls, it's easy to grab. Use cut the majority of the time, unless the fish are really active....

If it's a wide open bite, the bait acceleration in a bump program will often outperform the stall of a cut program.

When HUNT Mode is active, you will always see a **running timer on the screen.**

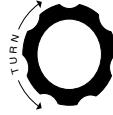

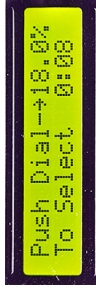

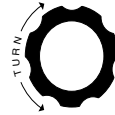

To Trolling Throttle Screen

Right turn of dial

Left turn of dial



Turn dial to change value

The throttle is live and responds to changes during programming. This gives you instant feedback as to how your boat responds to those changes.



Short press of dial
Changes resolution

Throttle:
1.0% or 0.1% steps

Time:
1 or 5 seconds

LONG press of dial
Stores value

If stored value was a throttle, return to here.

If stored value was time, HUNT is resumed.
